

**LYON TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE #39**

The Township of Lyon, Roscommon County, Michigan ordains:

SECTION 1: TITLE

This ordinance shall be known and cited as the Lyon Township No Parking Ordinance.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS

The word "Parking" wherever used in this ordinance is defined to mean allowing a vehicle to remain standing.

SECTION 3: REGULATIONS

No automobile, truck, or other vehicle shall be parked on either side of Sam-O-Set Boulevard within 30 feet east of the intersection of Sam-O-Set Boulevard and McKinley Avenue, or on either side of Albemarle Boulevard between Ironwood Avenue and Bass Avenue, or in any posted area.

SECTION 4: SANCTIONS OF VIOLATION

Any person or other entity who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance is responsible for a municipal civil infraction as defined by Michigan law and subject to a civil fine of \$10.00. Additionally, the violator may be required to pay costs related to direct or indirect expenses to which the township has been put in connection with the violation. In no case, however, shall costs of less than \$9.00 or more than \$500.00 be ordered. A violator of this ordinance shall also be subject to such additional sanctions, remedies, and judicial orders as are authorized under Michigan law. Each day a violation of this ordinance continues to exist constitutes a separate violation.

Effective Date: This ordinance shall take effect within 30 days after publication.
