MICHIGAN TOWNSHIP PARTICIPATING RISK REDUCTION GRANT PROGRAM

At a regular work session meeting of the Lyon Township Board, Roscommon County, Michigan, held at the Lyon Township Hall on the 10th day of November 2021 at 12:30 p.m.

The resolution is offered and was moved by Board Member _____ and seconded by Board Member _____.

WHEREAS, Clerk Schnell requesting approval to apply for a Risk Reduction Grant Program (RRGP), sponsored by the Michigan Township Participating Plan. The Risk Reduction Grant cycle opens October 1, 2021 and closes November 30, 2021.

WHEREAS, Clerk Schnell will be named the project manager who will administer the funds through the Township Clerk's office, will be knowledgeable in the total project, and serve as a contact for the Par Plan.

WHEREAS, Clerk Schnell has presented to the Board the description of the project including contractor/vendor itemized bids, a list of the items and services to be purchased. The total cost of the project is \$9982.00. The total amount of the RRGP grant is \$2500.00.

WHEREAS, The RRGP grant will specifically be used to place security cameras around the Lyon Township Compost/Recycling site, Park 27, Phoenix Park and Samoset Park. The measurable benefits of this project will help with the security of the Lyon Township PArks and services.

WHEREAS, Clerk Schnell will follow the guidelines and Format of the specific grant application and has noted that this project will take approximately 90days from start to finish to complete once the grant has been approved by the Michigan Township Participating Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Township Board has been advised and has approved the writing of a risk reduction grant application by Clerk Schnell, that the grant is sponsored by Michigan Township Participating Plan. Clerk Schnell will be the project manager and serve as a contact for the Par Plan. The Grant will be used to place a Security System consisting of cameras, installed software, programming of computers, and installing necessary cabling. The benefits of the project are to help with the security of the Lyon Township Grounds.

The total amount of the RRGP grant is \$2500.00 and the total cost of the project is \$9982.00. The Township Board has approved the completed Project as described.
