June 18	Delilah DeWylde		High octane rockabilly duo on upright bass and guitar performing rock music and country classics from the mid-late 1950's

July 2	Railcar Graffiti		Railcar Graffiti has been putting on an energetic, engaging and entertaining good time for crowds in Michigan since 2014. They bring their own captivating brand of folk with influences from American old-time string band and Celtic roots.
July 9	The Goofy Foot Band		The Goofy Foot Band is a duo from Michigan. Their style of music is a mix of rockabilly, rock and roll and classic country all rolled up into one with a punk rock heart. The band consists of John Burnett (lead vocals and guitar) and Nick Kanakis (upright bass and backup vocals).
