**UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE ADOPTION**

An ordinance to adopt by reference the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages.

**PURPOSE AND INTENT**

**TOWNSHIP OF LYON TOWNSHIP**

**ORDAINS:**

**TITLE**

This ordinance shall be known and cited as Lyon Township Uniform Traffic Code Adoption.

**SECTION 3**

**REGULATIONS**

THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF LYON TOWNSHIP, ROSCOMMON COUNTY, MICHIGAN  
ORDAINS:

**CODE ADOPTED.**

The Uniform traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages promulgated by the Commissioner of State Police on February 14, 1958, and published in Supplemental No. 13, and as amended both on February 14, 1961 and published in supplement No 25, and on February 28, 1968 and published in supplement #54 to the 1954 Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with Public Act of 1956, State of Michigan, is hereby adopted by reference as in this ordinance modified.

**REFERENCE IN CODE**

References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to “governmental Unit” shall mean the Township of Lyon, Roscommon County, Michigan.

**NOTICE TO BE PUBLISHED**

The Township Clerk shall publish this ordinance in the manner by law and at the same time publish a supplementary notice setting forth the purpose of the said Uniform Traffic Code and of the fact that complete copies of the Code are available at the office of the clerk for inspection by and distribution of the public at all times.

**SECTION 4**

**VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES**

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be responsible for a Municipal Civil Infraction as defined by Michigan statute, punishable by a civil fine determined in accordance with the schedule:

	<u>Minimum Fine</u>	
1 <sup>st</sup> offense within a 3-year period*		\$ 50.00
2 <sup>nd</sup> offense within a 3-year period*		\$125.00
3 <sup>rd</sup> offense within a 3-year period*		\$250.00
4 <sup>th</sup> or subsequent offense in a three-year period*		\$400.00

\*Determined on the basis of the date of commission of the offense(s).

Additionally, the violator shall pay costs which may include all expenses, direct and indirect, to which Lyon Township has been put in connection with the Municipal Civic Infraction.

In addition, any violation of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a public nuisance per se which may be abated in Circuit Court in lieu of or in addition to other civil infractions.

Each day that a violation exists shall constitute a separate offense for enforcement purposes.

**SECTION 5**

**SEVERABILITY**

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any clause, sentence, word, section or provision is declared void or unenforceable for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any other portion of this ordinance.

## **SECTION 6**

### **REPEAL**

#### **CONFLICTION ORDINANCES REPEALED**

All other ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of the Uniform Traffic Codes are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

## **SECTION 7**

### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

The Uniform Traffic Code will take effect in this government until June 12, 1971
