Boersma requested that the Township wait until after the October 25th deadline for write-in candidates.

Tom Metcalf asked the board to finish what they have started with the STR and Septic ordinances. He commented on the time, effort, and money spent so far and encouraged the board to follow through until our assignments end.

BOARD COMMENTS:

Maduri: We were tasked with coming up with a STR ordinance, Larry put together a committee to help with how to best serve our residents in an unbiased and fair way. We have a resolution to vote on that would give the number of STR's allowed in our township and a fee schedule to follow. Our septic ordinance is going very well and much progress has been made.

Boersma AV ballots are arriving daily. Our township has 1275 voters registered, 503 AV ballots were issued, and as of today, 109 AV ballots have been received.
