Parking

In most areas parking is limited. Please use your rental home's off-street parking only. Do not block neighbors' sidewalks, mailboxes, or driveways. Be especially mindful of winter season snowplowing routes.

Waste Pickup

All areas north of Pine Acres Drive in Lyon Township are picked up on Monday each week. Pine Acres Drive and all locations further south in Lyon Township are picked up on Tuesdays each week. In all cases, please leave any place you visit as clean or cleaner than you found it.

Pets

Pets are required to be on leashes whenever they are in un-enclosed areas or on public streets. When walking your pet, you are required to pick up and dispose of their waste. Do not allow your pet to trespass on any other property. Please also note that pets are not allowed on public beaches. Please be sure to let your pet enjoy our dog park located behind park 27 on Old 27.

Lyon Township Parks

Please be sure to enjoy Higgins Lake from our many road end accesses and Township Parks. Both Phoenix Park and Samoset Parks have playground facilities for children and access to Higgins Lake. In addition to playground equipment, Park 27 has an amphitheater, a walking trail, a dog park, volleyball court, basketball court, pickleball courts, tennis courts, and a pavilion. Road end docks are open to anyone that would like to use them. Please obey the rules that are posted. Docks on other people's properties are private and are not open to the public.

Boat Launching and Camping

Many of our road ends can launch smaller boats. There is also the Samoset Road launch on the east end of Samoset Road. If you like State Parks, we have the North Higgins Lake State Park at 11747 North Higgins Lake Drive, and a recently enlarged DNR boat launch on West Higgins Lake Drive.

ORV's and Golf Carts

Golf carts and ORV's are allowed on all county and local roads in Lyon Township, not on State of Michigan roads. Drivers must be 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license. Both are limited to operating at a maximum 25 mph. Drivers of both Golf Carts and ORV's are required to follow ALL traffic laws and are subject to the same penalties as other vehicles.
